NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, within corporate limits of City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 5 of subdivision known as Vista Hills, recorded in Plat Book P at Page 149, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a point at the Southwestern intersection of Ridgecrest Drive and Wellington Avenue, and running thence with the Southern side of Ridgecrest Drive, S. 38-26 W. 75 feet to a point at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence S. 38-19 E. 197 feet to a point on the northern side of a County Road at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence with the northern side of said Road, N. 50-28 E. 67.9 feet to a point at the Northwestern intersection of said County Road and Wellington Avenue; thence with the Western side of Wellington Avenue, N. 37-01 W. 212.9 feet to the point of beginning."

"ALSO, all my right, title and interest in and to the part of the Northern half of the County Road which lies directly to the rear of the lot herein described."
