in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. E. Robinson, as Trustee under B. M. McGee Trust Deed, his successors and Assigns:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Gantt Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as the major portion of Tract No. 2, as shown on a plat by John C. Smith, dated August 2 and 16, 1948, and recorded in Plat Book T, page 89, said tract herein conveyed containing 23.3 acres, one acre of the original tract situate in the northwest corner thereof having been retained by Mary S. Rogers. This property has the following metes and bounds, according to a plat by J. C. Smith, dated December 10, 1951:
