Margaret M. Nelson, (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto LAURENS FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, LAURENS, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of -----**Sixty-five Hundred and no/100**-----

DOLLARS (\$ **6500.00**), with interest thereon from date at the rate of -----**six**----- (**6** %)

per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Fairview Township, in the Town of Fountain Inn, with the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the northern edge of Givens Street, joint corner with land of H. N. Gault, running thence with said Street N. 63-45 W., 102 feet to an iron pin, joint corner with Lot No. 3 on said street as is shown by a plat of the Lurea M. Drummond property made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, October 9, 1951; thence with joint line of Lot No. 3 N. 26-33 E., 142.8 feet to an iron pin, joint corner with Lot Nos. 1, 2 & 3 as shown on said plat; thence with joint line of Lot No. 1 S. 63-02 E., 125 feet to an iron pin on line of land of H. N. Gault; thence with line of Gault land S. 35-48 W., 143.3 feet to an iron pin on Givens Street, the point of beginning, being known and designated as Lot No. 4 and bounded by Givens Street; Lot Nos. 1, 2 and 3 of the Lurea M. Drummond property as shown on said plat and land of H. N. Gault."

This being the identical lot conveyed to mortgagor by Lurea M. Drummond by deed dated October 20, 1951 and recorded in the office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Deed book 444, page 75.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
