TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: We, O. F. Bell and Pauline S. Bell

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Twenty-Two Hundred and No/100- - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 2200.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, lying about 4 miles west of Greenville Courthouse, on the North side of Easley Bridge Road, having the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a point on the North side of Easley Bridge Road, corner of Tract No. 4 (P. C. Sudduth Tract), and running thence along line of lot No. 4, N. 59-30 W. 1060 feet to pin, line of lot 5; thence with line of lot 5, N. 60-10 W. 51.6 feet to pin on line of tract 5, at branch; thence S. 5-20 E. 1084 feet to point on Easley Bridge Road; thence with North side of Easley Bridge Road, N. 87-30 E. 67.2 feet to pin in said road; thence with said road, N. 79-45 E. 55 feet to beginning corner."
