at the rate of Six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly, as above,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just outside the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the south side of David Street, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at corner of that lot of land conveyed by Gilreath to Beavers in 1918 (Vol. 44 at page 212), and running thence with said David Street, N. 23½ W. 43 1/3 feet to point, corner of Gilreath lot later owned by Murphree; thence S. 66½ W. 180 feet along line of last mentioned lot, to point; thence in a line parallel with David Street, S. 23½ E. 43 1/3 feet to point, corner of said Beavers lot; thence N. 66½ E. 180 feet along line of said Beavers lot to point of beginning on David Street.

This is the same property conveyed to me by Pink Davis by his deed dated Oct. 14, 1947, recorded in the R. M. C. office, and being same conveyed to said Pink Davis by Charles I. Gilreath by deed dated Apr. 28, 1919, recorded in Vol. 44 at page 513 in said R. M. C. office.
