SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Nannie C. Holland  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these  
Presents, am well and truly indebted to Farmers Bank of Simpsonville  
in the full and just sum of Twenty Three Hundred (\$2300.00)  
to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon from date  
at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly  
until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,  
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the  
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof  
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage  
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises  
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to  
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,  
sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
Farmers Bank of Simpsonville

All that piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being on Gilders  
Creek, which is a branch of Enoree River, County and State aforesaid,  
and being the same lands conveyed to Mrs. Nannie C. Holland by Julia  
D. Charles as Trustee by deed dated April 27, 1929, recorded in Deed  
Book 151, Page 22. The said tract of land is described by courses  
and distances as taken from the said deed as follows: BEGINNING at  
a stone formerly sweet gum and running thence N. 8 E. 5.00 to stone;  
thence N. 29 E. 10.20 to stone on old line; thence N. 39 W. 6.39 to  
stone in road leading to Westmoreland Mill; thence up said road N. 80  
W. 3.30 to stone; thence N. 26 W. 8.50 to stone; thence N. 29 W. 4.12  
to stone; in the Anderson Bridge Road; thence up that road S. 50 W.
