bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated  
as the greater portion of one of the lots subdivided and platted for Vivian Q. Guion,  
said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C,  
at page 131, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of Brockman Avenue at a point 65  
feet northeast of the intersection of Young Street, and running thence along  
Brockman Avenue, N. 10-30 E. 56 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 57-25 W. 163 feet,  
4 inches to an iron pin; thence S. 12-00 W. 55 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 57-25  
E. 168 feet, 8 inches to the beginning corner, on Brockman Avenue.

The above described lot is the greater portion of a lot designated on the  
above said plat as Lor No. 7, and is the greater portion of that lot of land conveyed
