Whereas, I, the said Nannie Johnson,

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these

Presents, am well and truly indebted to Bank of Travelers Rest, Travelers Rest, S. C.,

in the full and just sum of SIX HUNDRED FIFTY and no/100 (\$650.00) DOLLARS,

to be paid One (1) year after date,

with interest thereon from maturity.

at the rate of Six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually, in advance,

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, bounded by Gap Creek Road, Brooks Road, and lands of Thomasson and the Tankersley lands now owned by the Elks Club, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING on a walnut tree in the Gap Creek Road, at its intersection with the Brooks Road, and running thence in a westerly direction down the center of said Brooks Road to point, joint corner with tract of land conveyed by me to John Thomasson by deed; thence in a southerly direction along the line of the said last mentioned Thomasson property, to a point, joint corner with Thomasson and the Tankersley lands; thence in an easterly direction, with the line of the said Tankersley lands, to Gap Creek Road at 24-mile post; thence in a northerly direction, up center of the said Gap Creek Road to the beginning corner; and containing Eight (8) acres, more or less.
