RELEASE

For value received the Citizens Bank of Fountain Inn, South Carolina, does hereby release and forever discharge the lands hereinafter described from the lien of a mortgage given to it by Carrie D. Abercrombie, dated May 22, 1940 to secure a note in the sum of \$ 2500⁰⁰, said mortgage being recorded in the Office of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 294, at Page 115, expressly reserving however, the lien of said mortgage as to the other lands secured therein described.

The lands hereby released are described as follows: All that certain tract or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the corporate limits of the town of Fountain Inn, S.
