NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Northwestern side of Cammer Avenue, near the City of Greenville, being shown as lot No. 27 on plat of property of C. F. Cammer made by R. E. Dalton, in February 1923, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron bin on the Northwestern side of Commer Avenue, 225 feet Southwest from Marietta Street, at corner of lot No. 26, and running thence with the line of said lot, N. 48-48 W. 197.8 feet to an iron bin in line of the Jenkinson property; thence with the line of said property, S. 44-17 W. 75.1 feet to an iron bin, corner of lot No. 28; thence with the line of lot No. 28, S. 48-48 E. 201.1 feet to an iron bin on Cammer Avenue; thence with the Northwestern side of Cammer Avenue, N. 41-12 E. 75 feet to the beginning corner."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by G. F. Cammer by deed dated August 26, 1952, recorded in Volume 247 at Page 46.
