SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Earl (J.E.) Forrester

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these

Presents, am well and truly indebted to the First National Bank of Greenville, S.C. as trustee under agreement with Lucy Poe Sparkman

in the full and just sum of ....Fifteen Hundred...(\$1500.00)...Dollars

, to be paid \$375.00 on December 6, 1952, and a like amount on the 6th day of each and every succeeding 6th month thereafter until paid in full,

, with interest thereon from date hereof

at the rate of 5 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal: and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

First National Bank of Greenville, S. C. as Trustee under agreement with Lucy Poe Sparkman, its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, in School District 7G (205) on the surface treated road leading from Mauldin, S. C. to Pelham, S. C., containing two (2) acres, more or less, according to a plat of the property of J. C. Verdin, made by J. Coke Smith on May 5, 1944, and, according to said plat, described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on said road at the corner of property now or formerly owned by J. C. Verdin, and running thence S. 34-30 W. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 50-30 W. 420 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 34-30 E. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 50-30 E. 420 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Earl (J.E.) Forrester on August 13, 1951, by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Deed Book 440 at Page 6, by A. E. Henderson.
