(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto LAURENS FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, LAURENS, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the

per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Fairview Township, and located on the South side of Cox Street in or near the Town limits of Simpsonville, S. C., and being more fully described, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Cox Street 260 feet West of the intersection of Cox Street and the newly cut street; thence 145 feet S. 1½ West to an iron pin on New Street; thence along New Street 100 feet S. 75½ West to an iron pin on said street; thence N. 1½ East 198 feet to an iron pin on Cox Street; thence along Cox Street S. 72-3/4 East 100 feet to an iron pin and same being the beginning point.

The above described property is the portion of the same property conveyed to E. G. Whitmire, Jr., by Docia P. Barbrey by deed dated Sept. 29, 1951, and recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 445 at page 472.

This being the identical land conveyed to the mortgagor by E. G. Whitmire, Jr., by deed dated June 4, 1952, and recorded simultaneously with this mortgage in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
