"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of

Broadus Avenue and Manly Street, being shown as the eastern portion of Lot No. 2, Block 5, on plat of Boyce Addition recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book ZZ, at Pages 934 and 935, and having according to a survey by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May, 1952, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of East North Street, said pin being 100 feet west from the southwest corner of the intersection of East North Street and Manly Street and running thence along the line of Lot No. 3 S. 16-07 E. 184.7 feet to an iron pin on the northern edge of a 15 foot alley; thence along the northern edge of said alley S. 76-0 W. 17.83 feet to an iron pin; thence through Lot No. 2 N. 16-07 W. 184.7 feet to an iron pin on the south side of East North Street; thence along the south side of East North Street; thence along the south side of East North Street North Street.
