	I, W. R. Cordell, of Greenville County, SEND GREETING:
	WHEREAS, I the said W. R. Cordell
	in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the
	full and just sum of Four Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100 (\$ 4,500.00)
	Dollars, with interest at the rate of six $(6\%)$ per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of
•	Forty and No/100 (\$\frac{40.00}{})\$ Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.
	NOW.KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said W. R. Cordell in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment

Cordell in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:
	"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed
	thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, School District 160, formerly 6-E, being known and designated as Lo No. 7 of a revised plat of the property of W. R. Cordell made by Dalton & Neves,
	March, 1952, recorded in Plat Book Z, at page 44, said lot being a portion of a resubdivision of Lot No. 129, of Map 4, of a subdivision known as Camilla Park as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 117, and having, according to the Dalton revised plat, the following metes and bounds to-wit:
	"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of a 100-foot right-of-way for a Duke Power Company transmission line at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7, which pir is 220 feet south of the Old Easley Bridge Road, and running thence along the joint line of said Lots 6 and 7, N. 87-51 E. 183.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 21-0 E. 35. feet to an iron pin; thence S. 9-30 W. 37.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 87-51 W. 187.5 feet to an iron pin on the east side of said transmission line right-of-way; thence along the east side of said right-of-way, N. 2-09 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said

premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being a portion of the property conveyed to me by P. G. James by deed dated November 25, 1949 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in
