"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed Greenville, near the thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville, and near the Old Rutherford Road, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Davis Street, corner of lot now or formerly owned by Babb, and of Lot No. 1, and running thence in an easterly direction in the edge of Davis Street 52 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence N. 31-45 E. 90.5 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lots Nos. 1, 2, 17 and 18; thence in a westerly direction with dividing line of Lots Nos. 1, 17 and 18, 33 fee to an iron pin, corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 18, also to line of Babb lot: thence S. 14 W. 115 feet to an iron pin in edge of Davis Street, the beginning corner, and being known and designated as Lot No. 1 as shown on plat and survey made by Will D. Neves, July 25, 1914; being the same conveyed to us by Jeanne D. Threatt by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded.
