ALL that certain lot of land, with improvements thereon, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the East side of Gridley Street, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lots Nos. 26 and 26 of Section A on an Occupation Map of Lots on the East side of Gridley St. made by Dalton & Neves in October 1927, recorded in Plat Book "G", at Page 160 and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the East side of Gridley Street, 168 feet North from Martin Street, at corner of Lot No. 27, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 84-21 E. 189.1 feet to a stake on an alley; thence with the Western side of said alley, N. 19-50 W. 100 feet to a stake at corner of lot No. 25; thence with the line of said lot, S. 80-46 w. 165.8 feet to a stake on Gridley Street; thence with the Eastern side of Gridley Street, S. 11-19 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
