I, Dee R. Berry

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Dee R. Berry

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these Presents, I am well and truly indebted to Bank of Piedmont

in the full and just sum of (\$300.00) Three Hundred and No/100
to be paid Payable one year from date

with interest thereon from maturity
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid in advance

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Bank of Piedmont

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said Dee R. Berry

in hand well and truly paid by the said Bank of Piedmont at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,

sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of Piedmont, its successor and assigns forever;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just East of Town of Piedmont, containing four acres, more or less, adjoining the lands of Jack Fisher, S. M. Jones and Mrs. Sunnie Gambrell and others, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point in center of road at corner of John Hooper's property, on the line of Jack Fisher; thence along the line of Jack Fisher, N. 64- E. 2 chains 37 links to an angle in road; thence S. 74 E. 1.00 to an angle; thence S. 88 E. 1.06 to a point in road, new corner; thence S. 18 W. 10.25 to a stone on line of Mrs. Sunnie Gambrell; thence along line of Mrs. Sunnie Gambrell, N. 89 W. 4.15 to a stone, new corner of John Hooper; thence along a new line of John Hooper, N. 18 E. 9.26 to point of beginning. This property is a part of the property known as the Garrison lands.
