Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. with the buildings and improvements thereon, about six and one-half miles South of the City of Greenville, on the South side of East Gantt Street, and being known as Lot No. 22, as shown on plat of property of Albert Q. Taylor, made by Dalton & Neves, May, 1946, and recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book P, Page 49, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
