at the rate of four (4%) per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, S. C. on the East side of Main Street, being known and designated as 23 South Main Street and having according to survey by J. C. Hill, dated July, 1947, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
