MARY McAFEE HOLLIDAY (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Twelve Thousand and No/100 - - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 12,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of four & one-half per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the south side of Woodvale Avenue, in that area recently annexed to the City of Greenville, being shown as Lots 255 and 256 on second revision of the plat of Traxler Park, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, March 1923, recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book F, at Pages 114-115, said lots having a frontage of 142.2 feet on the south side of Woodvale Avenue, with a depth of 247.7 feet on the east side, a depth of 234.9 feet on the west side, and being 141.3 feet across the rear.

The above described property is the same conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of James C. Holliday, Jr., dated March 9, 1943, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 256, at Page 346, and by deed of Romaine Barnes, et al, dated June 22, 1945, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 277, at Page 127.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
