WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Thirty-Five Hundred and No/100- - - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 3500.00 ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%)

per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Eastern side of Willis Avenue, near the City of Greenville, being a portion of lot 30, Section B, as shown on plat of Property of Alice M. and H. H. Willis, made by W. J. Riddle, November 1939, recorded in Plat Book K at Page 271, and according to a survey made by J. C. Hill, on April 4, 1953, is described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Eastern side of Willis Avenue, at corner of lot 31, and running thence with line of said lot, S. 80-30 E. 383 feet to a stake at corner of lot 46; thence with the line of said lot, S. 36-15 W. 100 feet to a stake; thence N. 80-15 W. 390 feet to a stake on Willis Avenue; thence with the Eastern side of Willis Avenue, N. 19-32 E. 25 feet to a stake; thence continuing with the Eastern side of Willis Avenue, N. 6-30 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner. The eastern portion of said lot being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by deed recorded in Volume 403 at Page 415 and the western portion being the same acquired through the Will of Garrett Crow."
