KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the said Vernon Lee Cantrelland Aldean Stokes Cantrell , in consideration of the said debt and sums of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Citizens Building & Loan Association, Greer, S. C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the said mortgagors in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, O'Neal Township, lecated about one mile east from Berry's Mill and about one mile southwest from Jordan High School, lying on the west side of the road that leads from the Berry's Mill to the Jordan Road by way of the old Whilden place, being triangular in shape, being bounded on the north by other lands of W. A. Stekes, on the east by the said road and lands of Ray Slean, and on the southwest by lands of Tom Sloan (formerly Stokes), and being a part of the same land that was conveyed to W. A. Stekes by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 269, at page 243, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

BEGINNING on a nail and stopper in the center of the said road, joint corner of the lands of Ray Slean and of Tom Slean, and runs thence with the said road and the line of Ray Slean, N. 2-15 W. 600 feet to a stake on the west edge of the surfacing of the said road; thence a new line N. 88-45 W. 334 feet to a stake; thence S. 7-45 W. 115.6 feet to a stake; thence S. 82-54 W. 40 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of the Tom Slean land; thence with the line of the TomSlean land S. 39-00 E. 650 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, and containing three and twelve one-hundredths (3-12) acres, more or less.
