All that piece, parcel or triangular strip of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate and being a portion of the rear of Lot No. 106, according to plat of Country Club Estates, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book G, at pages 190-191, and having, according to more recent survey prepared by Dalton & Neves in April, 1953, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
