"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northern side of John Street, known as No. 204 John Street, in the City of Greenville, Greenville Township, being shown and delineated as Lot No. 22, Block 1, Page 23 of the City Block Book; bounded on the north by Lot No. 25 now or formerly owned by W.E. Hill; on the east by lots now or formerly owned by Methodist Protestant Church and Dora Taylor; on the south by John Street; and on the west by Lot No. 21 now or formerly owned by A. S. Riggins, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of John Street, which pin is 105 1/4 feet from the western side of Lloyd Street, and running thence along the line of the lots of Methodist Protestant Church and Dora Taylor 120 feet to a point in line of the Hill lot; thence with the line of said lot in a westerly direction 60 feet to a point in line of the Riggins lot; thence with the line of said lot in a southerly direction 120 feet to a point on John Street; thence with the northern side of John Street in an easterly direction 60 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
