MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, Edward W. Turner and Kathleen A, Turner, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, we the said Edward W. Turner and Kathleen A. Turner

in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the

full and just sum of Five Thousand, Nine Hundred and No/100 - - - - (\$5,900.00)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of

Forty-Four and 74/100 - - - - - - - - - - (\$ 44.74) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of Holmes Drive at the corner of Lot No. 69 and running thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 69 and 70, N. 89-56 W. 130 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 68; thence along the joint line of Lots No. 68 and 70, N. 70-13 W. 93.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 11-40 W. 43.3 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 71; thence along the joint line of Lots No. 70 and 71, S. 88-29 E. 233.4 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of Holmes Drive; thence along the line of Holmes Drive, N. 4-56 W. 80 feet to the point of beginning, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
