NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, at the Southwest corner of the intersection of Keowee Avenue and Elsie Avenue, in the City of Greenville, being shown as part of lots 32 and 33, as shown on a plat of South Cherokee Park, recorded in Plat Book A & Page 130, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Elsie Avenue, formerly Saluda Street, at a point 112 feet from the intersection of Keowee Avenue and Elsie Avenue, and running thence along the Southside of Elsie Avenue, S. 63 E. 60 feet to iron pin at corner of 15 foot alley; thence with said Alley, S. 27 W. 130 feet to iron pin at rear corner of lot 31; thence with line of lot 31, N. 63-30 W. 60 feet to iron pin; thence across lots 32 and 33, N. 27 E. 130 feet to an iron pin on Elsie Avenue, the point of beginning.
