We, W.H. Phillips, Sr. and W.E. Harrison of Spartanburg County

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, We, the said W. H. Phillips, Sr. and W.E. Harrison are

well and truly indebted to Woodruff State Bank in the full and just sum of Seventy-Four Hundred (\$7400.00) Dollars as evidenced by our promissory note of even date herewith, the said note being due and payable as follows: the full amount to be paid One (1) year from date with interest thereon at the rate of Seven per cent annually. It provides that in the event of default on the payment of any one installment due, the entire amount due and owing shall immediately become due and payable at the option of the holder. All interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; the payments to be applied first to interest, the balance to principal. It further provides for an additional ten per cent Attorney's fees in case of suit or collection by an Attorney.

granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents DO grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Woodruff State Bank, its successors and assigns, All that piece, parcel or tract of land lying, being, and situate at the city limits of the Town of Fountain Inn, in Greenville and Laurens Counties, State of South Carolina, and containing 70 Acres, more or less, shown and designated on plat of H.L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, Anderson, Ga., dated March 9 and 10, 1953 of the W.H. Phillips, Sr. and W.E.
