Edwards, made by R. E. Dalton in April 1939, and when described as a whole contains the following metes and bounds, to wit:

"Beginning at an iron pin on the southern side of Lee Road, at the northwestern corner of Lot No. 19, and running thence S. 19-17 E. 1408.8 ft. to an iron pin at rear corner of Lot No. 1; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 1, N. 43 E. 361.8 ft. to an iron pin at corner of lot now or formerly owned by E.
