MORTGAGE OF REAL EST

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:
I, Lawrence E. Short, same as L. E. Short, of Greenville County, SEND GREETINGS:
WHEREAS, I the said Lawrence E. Short
in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the
full and just sum of Fourteen Thousand, Seven Hundred and No/100 (\$ 14,700.00 )  four and one-half (4-1/2%)
Bollars, with interest at the rate of six/(6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of
Ninety-Three and 01/100 (\$ 93.01 ) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment
mereor to the said First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Greenville, ac-

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed
thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 158 of the property of Central Development Corporation according to a plat of record in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB at pages 22-23, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
"BEGINNING at a point on the Southern side of Dellwood Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 157 and 158, and running thence with the joint line of Lots 157 and 158, S. 27-34 E. approximately 206 feet to a point in a branch, the joint rear corner of Lots 157 and 158; thence with said branch as a line approximately S. 54-39 W. approximately 75.75 feet to a point, the joint rear corner of Lots 158 and 159; thence with the joint line of Lots 158 and 159, N. 27-34 W. approximately 216.2 feet to a point on the southern side of Dellwood Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 158 and 159; thence with the southern side of Dellwood Drive, N. 62-26 E. 75 feet to the point of beginning, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
