"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Austin Township, School District 5-B, in the southern out-skirts of the Town of Mauldin, and being known and designated as all of Lot No. 14, and the eastern portion of Lot No. 15, of the subdivision of the property of C. A. Rice and Jessie M. Rice as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "J" at page 153, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southwest corner of the intersection of the Conestee-Pelham Road with Cemetery road, and running thence along the south side of said Pelham-Conestee Road, N. 85-07 W. 144.5 feet to an iron pin in the front line of said Lot No. 15; thence in a new line across Lot 15, S. 3-15 W. 351.6 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Cemetery road; thence along the north side of said Cemetery road, N. 24-15 E. 373 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
