SEND GREETING:

Whereas, WE, the said Jack H. Putnam and Marva Lee Putnam
in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, am well and truly indebted to Farmers Bank of Simpsonville
in the full and just sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars
, to be paid Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars each three months
hereafter until paid in full

, with interest thereon from date
at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Farmers Bank of Simpsonville

All that piece, parcel and lot of land known as tract number
three in a survey of the lands of W. A. Thomason, according to plat
made by W. J. Riddle, dated Nov. 4, 1950. It lies about 1 1/2 miles
southward from the Town of Mauldin in Austin Township, Greenville
County, S. C. and is shown on the Riddle plat by courses and distances
as follows: It begins in the center of a county road at joint corner
of tracts numbers 2 and 3 on the Riddle plat and runs thence with the
line of tract number 2 N. 50 W. 1274.5 feet to iron pin; thence S.
19 W. 100 feet to iron pin; thence S. 12-30 W. 162 feet to iron
pin; thence S. 21 W. 118 feet to iron pin; thence crossing maple creek
