sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the saidThe First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., as Trustee under
agreement with Virginia Norris dated August 21, 1953,All that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the west
side of Westfield Street, BEGINNING at an iron pin on said Street at
corner of Lot No. 1 of the subdivision of the lot conveyed to James B.
League by Kate Hyde Sloan by deed dated May 31, 1912, and as shown by
plat of same, and running thence N. 69-15 W. 174.5 feet to iron pin; thence
S. 21 W. 41.9 feet to iron pin; thence S. 69-15 E. 174.5 feet to pin on
Westfield Street; and thence with Westfield Street N. 21 E. 41.9 feet to
the beginning corner, including the right to the use of the joint driveway
between said lot and Lot No. 1 and subject to the like use of said joint
