SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said **Mary Kay Booth**  
in and by **my** certain **promissory** note in writing, of even date with these  
Presents, **am** well and truly indebted to **H. K. Townes, Attorney**

in the full and just sum of **ELEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY FIVE & NO/100 (\$1165.00) DOLLARS**  
to be paid **\$75.00** six months after date and **\$75.00** on each  
succeeding six months for a period of four (4) years, then remainder to be paid

with interest thereon from \_\_\_\_\_ date  
at the rate of **7** per centum per annum, to be computed and paid **semi-annually** out of semi-  
annual payments \_\_\_\_\_ until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,  
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the  
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof  
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage  
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises  
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to  
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.  
Attorney's fee in event of suit is to be **\$125.00**.

sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

All that tract of lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of  
South Carolina, on the southeast side of the Anderson Road, and having the following  
metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in center of the Anderson Road, at corner of the property  
of Mrs. Hudgens, and running thence along the line of her property, S. 32-20 E., 106.3  
feet to an iron pin; thence still with the line of the Hudgens property, S. 43-00 E.  
71.5 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of the Hudgens property; thence S. 44-30 W.,  
50.5 feet to an iron pin in line of property of C. J. Moody; thence along the line  
of C. J. Moody property, N. 48-10 W., 166.0 feet to a point in the center of the  
Anderson Road; thence along the center line of the Anderson Road, N. 38-20 E.,
