April , 19 54, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of March , 19 74.

Now, Know All Men, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the Westerly side of Beatrice Street, near the City of Greenville, S. C., and being shown as Lot No. 58 on the plat entitled Map No. 1 of Camilla Park, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Flat Book "G", pages 224 and 225, said lot fronting 68 feet on the Westerly side of Beatrice Street and having a depth of 196.1 feet on the Southerly side, a depth of 197 feet on the Northerly side, and being 67.95 feet across the rear.

The mortgagor covenants that until the mortgage has been paid in full he will not execute or file for record any instrument which imposes a restriction upon the sale or the occupancy of the mortgaged property, on the basis of race, color or creed.
