"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 on Plat of Lanneau Drive Highlands according to Plat Book D at Pages 288 and 289 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin 39.5 feet from the Northeastern intersection of Lanneau Drive and Ottoway Drive and running thence with Lanneau Drive N. 10-11 E. 129.5 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with Lanneau Drive N. 1-09 E. 108 feet to iron pin; thence S. 26-13 E. 200 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 14, 13, 21 and 20; thence with line of Lot No. 21 S. 63-47 W. 126.5 feet to beginning corner and being the same lot conveyed to Mortgager by Deed recorded in Volume 487 at Page 14.
