Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Weston St, being a joint corner of the property of the grantee and grantor and running N 64 W 36 for a distance of 80 feet to an rion pin; thence turning and running S 36 W 10 for a distance of 150 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S 64- 36 E for a distance of 80 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running N 36-10 E for a distance of 150 feet to an iron pin and being the beginning corner.
