Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of GREEN VILLE of Greenville, being the major portion of lot 14, as shown on plat of the J. E. Flynn Estate, made by H. S. Brockman in November 1940, recorded in Plat Book 0 at Page 75, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Eastern side of Reid's School Road, at corner of the right-of-way of P & N Railroad, and also at corner of U. S. Highway No. 2, and running thence with right-of-way of said railroad, N. 48-3 E. 344.5 feet to a stake; thence N. 1-26 W. 67.9 feet to a stake at corner of property of W.
