Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book BB, at page 182, & 133, said lot fronting 124 feet along the West side of Lakecrest Drive and running back to a depth of 127.7 feet on the North side, to a depth of 145.4 feet on the South side and being 133.5 feet across the rear.
