All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being situate on the Southerly side of Lake Fairfield Drive, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Garolina, being known and designated as Lot #85, according to Plat of Section 1 of Lake Forest, prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service July, 1953, as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book GG, at page 17, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
