WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of United States of America, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Four Thousand and No/100- - - Dollars (\$ 4000.00 ), with interest from date at the rate of Four & One-Half per centum ( 4½ %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association in Greenville, S. C. or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Twenty-Five and 32/100- - - - - Dollars (\$ 25.32 ), commencing on the first day of June, 1954, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of May, 1974.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina: in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot # 19, Block K, as shown on a plat of Fair Heights, recorded in Plat Book F at Page 257, and being more particularly described according to a recent survey prepared by J. C. Hill, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the East side of Fairview Avenue, which pin is 250 feet South of the intersection of Fairview Avenue and Decatur Street, and is the joint front corner of lots 19 and 20, and running thence with joint line of said lots, S. 58-40 E. 136.5 feet to iron pin; thence S. 31-20 W. 50 feet to iron pin; thence N. 58-40 W. 136.9 feet to iron pin in the East side of Fairview Avenue; thence with said Avenue, N. 31-47 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagors by Henry C. Painter, Jr. by deed to be recorded.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
