All that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the south side of Wilson Avenue, in the City of Greer, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being a portion of Lots Nos. 5 and 6 of the Property of Nancy W. Finley and Ellen W. Crain, survey and plat thereof by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated June 24, 1941, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:
