J. Ambrose Walker to John A. Park for the original sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars, dated May 7, 1951, recorded in Vol.498 at page 203 in said R. M. C. office, and which was assumed by me. It is understood and agreed that the failure of the mortgagoremiums, when due, shall constitute a default, and that the mortgagorem may, at his option, foreclose this mortgagorem or pay said items and add the same so paid, to the principal amount of the debt, and they shall bear interest at the same rate.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members. Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
