"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Onesl Township near the Washington Baptist Church and School, lying on the East side of the road that leads from the Washington Church-Oneal Road to Mosteller's Mill, bounded on the north and esat by lands of Mrs. Hattie V.
