All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the east side of Crosby Circle in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 124 on plat of Paramount Park, made by Piedmont Engineering Service; dated July 1949 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "W", at page 57, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
