Douglas Wilson & Co., in the City of Greenville, S. C., or at such other place either within or without the State of South Carolina, as the owner of this obligation may from time to time designate, of the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 - - - - - Dollars

with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of 4½ per centum per annum, said interest to be paid on the - - - - - day of - - - - - 19 - - - - - and thereafter said interest

and principal sum to be paid in installments as follows: Beginning on the 1st day of November 19 54, and on the 1st day of each month thereafter the

sum of \$ 41.69 to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the 1st day of September 19 79, and the balance

of said principal sum to be due and payable on the 1st day of October 19 79, the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 41.69 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate

of 4½ per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 7,500.00 or so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal. Said principal and interest to be paid at the par of exchange and net to the obligee, it being thereby expressly agreed that the whole of the said principal sum shall become due after default in the payment of interest, taxes, assessments, water rate or insurance, as hereinafter provided.
