PARCEL NO. 4

RIVERBEND STEAM PLANT

The steam electric generating plant of the Company known as its Riverbend Steam Plant located on Catawba River in Gaston County, North Carolina, being the property described in Supplemental Mortgage dated March 12, 1930, and being the property described as "Group B" in Supplemental Mortgage dated September 1, 1936, and being the property referred to as "Parcel No. 2" in Supplemental Mortgage dated January 1, 1941. As of January, 1941, this plant had an installed capacity of 165,000 KW. Two additional units with total installed capacity of 200,000 KW were completed and placed in operation prior to December, 1952, and an additional unit with installed capacity of 133,000 KW was completed and placed in operation August, 1954. As an addition to the plant there is now under construction a unit with installed capacity of 133,000 KW, which unit is expected to be completed and placed in operation November, 1954, at which time the Riverbend Steam Plant will have a total installed capacity of 631,000 KW with all necessary switching stations and step-up transformers.
