We, David Lee Williams and Willie Nell Williams SEND GREETING:

Whereas, we, the said David Lee Williams and Willie Nell Williams  
in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these  
Presents, we are well and truly indebted to Bank of Piedmont  
in the full and just sum of (\$250.00) Two Hundred Fifty and No/100  
, to be paid Payable one year from date

, with interest thereon from maturity  
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid in advance  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that we, the said David Lee Williams and Willie Nell Williams, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Bank of Piedmont according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us, the said David Lee Williams and Willie Nell Williams, in hand well and truly paid by the said Bank of Piedmont at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of Piedmont, its successors and assigns forever;

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated and being in Grave Township, Greenville County and State of South Carolina, containing one and two tenths acres (1.2) more or less, and being the following description:

BEING at a point in center of surface tracted road running between S 80-30 W 248.2 feet to an iron pin, thence along land of J. H. Payne owned by J. H. Payne N 7-08 W 216.2 feet to an iron pin in center of surface tracted road; thence along surface tracted road S 80-30 E 216.5 feet to an iron pin in center of surface tracted road; thence along land of J. H. Payne and along surface tracted road S 14-30 E 230.4 feet to an iron pin in surface tracted road at point of origin. This being according to plat made by W. Carl Smith, July 9, 1941 and said tract of land containing one and two tenths acres of land.
