Now, Know All Men, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville State of South Carolina; on the southeastern side of Rockwood Drive in the City of Greenville, being the major portion of Lot 76 as shown on plat of Rockwood Park recorded in Plat Book "S" at Pages 168 and 169 and according to a recent survey made by R. W. Dalton is described as follows:

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REGINNING at a stake on the southeastern side of Rockwood Drive 108.1 feet southwest from Meyers Drive at corner of Lot 75 and running thence with the line of said lot S. 51-34 E. 254.2 feet to a stake; thence S. 44-17 W. 75.5 feet to a stake at corner of property now or formerly owned by James C.
