all that tract or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. on the northern side of Richbourg Road and being known and designated as Lot No. 32 on a plat of the property of Morningside by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated December, 1952 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "FF", at pages 83, 84 and 85 and being more fully described as follows:
