EXTENSION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 18th day of February, A. D. 1955, between the Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association of Greenville, South Carolina, a corporation, chartered under the Laws of the United States, hereinafter called "FIDELITY", and Harrison R. King and Jean H. King, hereinafter called "OBLIGORS", WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS Fidelity is the owner and holder of a note dated 14th of March, 1952, executed by Harrison R. King and Jean H. King, and delivered to Fidelity in the original principal amount of \$6800.00, and secured by a mortgage upon said premises shown as lot #15, on plat of Parish, Gower, and Martin, recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book Hat Fage 17, said premises being located on the Eastern side of Biltmore Drive, and said mortgage being recorded in the R. M. C. O fice for Greenville County in Book of Mortgages 525 at Page 57, title to which mortgaged premises is now vested in the said Harrison R. King and Jean H. King, subject to said note and mortgage which are hereinafter called the obligation and said Obligors have requested Fidelity to extend the time for performance of the obligation; NOW THEREFORE,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That it is agreed in consideration of the mutual agreements herein that:

1. Fidelity agrees to extend the time for payment of the principal indebtedness of \$6424.36 now remaining unpaid under the obligation so that it shall be payable as follows: \$41.21 on the 1st day of March, 1955, and a like payment of \$41.21 upon the first day of each and every month thereafter until paid in full, and if not sooner so paid, the balance on the first day of November, 1972, said payments to be applied first to interest at the rate of Four (4%) per cent, the balance to principal.
